THRILLS, CHILLS, AND SPILLS AT SEASON OPENER

Despite a late winter storm that clobbered the eastern half of the U.S., hundreds of roadracers ignored the weather and packed into Oak Hill Raceway for the opening round of the CMRA sprint race series. While Texas was spared the worst part of the weather, it was still cold enough Saturday night to cause severe engine damage to several race bikes that were left unprotected. Raceday Sunday turned out to be sunny and cool and the grids were full with over 490 total entries.

First up on the race schedule was the Provisional Novice Race. As a new requirement for 1993, first time racers must successfully finish in this race before they are allowed to compete in other races. The race is split into three classes; heavy, medium, and lightweight superbike. The sight of 40 yellow shirted Provisional Novices all blipping their throttles was enough to cause several race officials to have an anxiety attack. As the three waves were flagged off however, it became evident that the riders school instructor had done his job. The race ran in an orderly fashion and only four of the forty failed to finish a better rate than most of the other classes. Jason Subt eventually ran down early leader Kenneth Cleveland on the last lap for the overall win while Jody Hudson maintained third. Ryan Curry won the mediumweight class ahead of Chris Byford and Mark Olson. Leading the way in the lightweights was Sean Getts, with Robert Fournierat and Albert Rodriguez in second and

third.

Usually a barn burner, Production 50 was turned into a yawner by Tommy Hickman, as he ran away to an un-contested win. Richard Celestial kept Chris Reed at bay for second. Randy Robinette was the Novice winner while Steve Ochoa got by Ross Smith mid race for second. Later in the day, Hickman returned to win the Super-50 class as well, but only after a knock down drag out with Stanley Huffman. Ray Anderson rode an extremely fast YSR-50 to the Novice win while Joseph Schtulmann got by Chris Newhouse on the last lap for second.

Then things got serious as the C Superstock / Production field took their places on the grid. Marcus McBain (literally) jumped into the lead but the blue flag turned to red a lap later for a turn three crash involving Pat Brown and Stephen Barnes. On the re-start, Robert Wright led the first lap but on lap two Michael Carter was the surprise leader and he held it on the third lap as well, ahead of Wright and McBain. Then on lap four things began to really heat up as James Schaefer and Jeb Bridgeman came up to join the party. Wright led lap four but was dropped to second by Schaefer and

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on lap six he was third behind Bridgeman. On the last lap, Wright got by Bridgeman but then crashed in turn six. Bridgeman was forced off the track to avoid Wright and wound up crashing as well. Unaware that the pressure was off, Schaefer turned a 1:28.58 to win ahead of McBain and Carter. James Anderson took the Novice win ahead of Chet Meyers and Bryant Driggers. After the race, as the crashers returned to the pits, an oil leak on Wright's machine somehow went undetected and he oiled the track. Clean up took almost an hour.

The Formula Clubman race featured a much anticipated showdown between National Champion Eric Falt on his #1 Rotax powered special and Moto Liberty's Doug Carmichael aboard a Honda RS-125. Eric jumped from the pole into an immediate lead while Carmichael carved through traffic. It took Doug only three laps to catch Eric and passing him wasn't much of a problem either. Doug went on to win by a handy margin with Charles Engle a distant third. Micah Stevenson piloted his Rotax to the Novice win ahead of fast learner Ryan Curry. Ernie Wukasch collected third.

Provo Utah's Robert Wright (who was just stopping by on the way home from Daytona) hit the \$500 jackpot in B Superstock by winning on a Suzuki GSXR 750. Kawasakis swept the next three places ridden by Joe Prussiano (who led the first three laps), Greg Abbott, and Mark Black. The talent level in this race was quite deep for a club event and just finishing in the top ten was a heck of an accomplishment. James Anderson wound up on top of the Novice heap with Bryant Driggers second and Trae Taute third. This race was red flagged on lap seven (and therefore scored on lap six) due to a crash involving Barry McMahon. He turned out to be O.K.

Eric Falt romped to the Unlimited Twins victory while Robert Bates secured second. Last year's Novice UT Champion Scott Dennis (who's killer hawk is not yet ready) rode a borrowed Honda XL600 to third place after Charles Engle's SRX broke a cylinder stud. Micah Stevenson (Ducati mounted this time) picked up his second win in the Novice division. John Jankowski and Jack Blankenship ran second and third.

Greg Abbott won the B Superbike race easily while Tracy LeBlanc came from behind to overtake John

Branch for second. Walter Walker scored his first win in the Novice division, ahead of James Anderson, Bryant Driggers, and a horde of others.

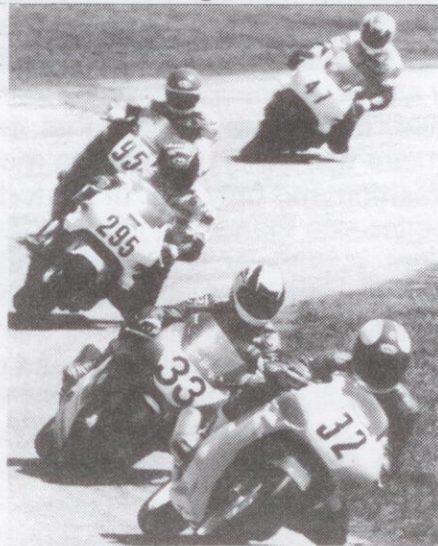
Kenneth Bailey controlled the Expert portion of D Production while Ben Absher took care of the Novice end. Chris Page got past Aaron Obenberger on lap six but yet another red flag backed up scoring to lap five giving Aaron the position. Chris Stobaugh out dueled Tony Lewis for the Vintage Four win ahead of Bobby Buce and R N Root.

Tracy LeBlanc ran away and hid from a huge field in A Superbike. Chris Rankin took care of second while Charlie Brown wrested third from Charlie Dill. Walter Walker wrapped up win number two in the Novice division ahead of Bob Reidmatten and Bryant Driggers.

It's awful early in the season to make predictions, but the Formula Two Championship already looks like a three horse race. With over a year of TZ experience under his belt, Steve Davison is currently the fastest and took round one handily. Chris Rankin wasn't too far behind. Look for Chris to challenge Steve later in the year. Kelly Moody (third place on his FZR400) is the spoiler and looks set to scoop up points if the TZ's should sieze. Aaron Obenberger was the Novice winner ahead of Ben Absher and Colin Fowler.

"Downtown" Charlie Brown wound up with the C Superbike win when the apparent winner, Marcus McBain, was docked five positions for rolling the start. Jeb Bridgeman was second and Chris Rankin third. Bryant Driggers won the Novice race ahead of Chet Meyer and Trae Taute. The first 14 machines were all CBR 600 Hondas.

The A Superstock race was not without some controversy. Robert Wright (who had missed the riders meeting and was unaware of the CMRA's

strict no rolling start policy) jumped the gun and drew the blue flag while Chris Rankin led the first lap ahead of Toby Grace. Wright went to the front on lap two while Mark Black worked his way into second. Then on lap five, a corner worker got excited about a crash and accidentally grabbed the red flag. Although the flag was only displayed briefly, it was enough to cause a lot of confusion as the riders tried to figure out if the race was still on or not. The race ran to it's six lap conclusion but the officials decided to score it based on lap four, the last clean lap. And the winner was....Mark Black, with Toby Grace second and Robert Marsh winning Suzuki bucks in third. James Anderson scored the A Production victory. Again, Chet Meyer and Trae Taute ran second and third.

Kelly Moody won the D Superbike race although Eric Falt did lead the first couple of laps. Robert Bates was third. Aaron Obenberger won again in the Novices besting Ben Absher and Chris Page.

W David Cheek took the Vintage victory overall while Provisional Novice Ryan Curry found himself right in the middle of a Triumph shootout between R N Root, Chris Stobaugh and Peter Pohlman. Curry correctly figured out that the safest place was in front. Stobaugh won the shootout, RN second, and Peter third.

Steve Davison doubled up in Formula One, although he had to fight off a serious challenge from Mark Black. Charlie Brown was third. Bruce Norris won the Novice Formula One race ahead of Jason Subt and Bob Reidmatten.

Yes, the action was wild and wooly but then, the first race of the season usually is. Will things settle down at the Speedway? See you there.

PLANO PLASTERS THE COMPETITION

It appears the small town of Plano has spawned yet another major endurance team as the brand new Plano Honda Racing Team debuted successfully by outrunning a 40 bike field in round one of the CMRA's Endurance Series. Owned by Bill Comegys, the CBR600F2 equipped team of Kelly Moody and Damon Harvey passed the CBR900RR of Northwest Honda in the pits and held them off in the second hour for the win. Lone Star Racing was third.

It was cold and sunny as the 40 bike field gridded for the start. The Legends were on the pole while Team TSBA and Northwest Honda were on row three. HSR Endurance, the Mediumweight Production champs from last year, were looking good in their brand new team leathers and have moved up into the MWS class for this year. Also moving up were last years lightweight champions, Blackfire Racing, who are now contesting the MWP category.

At 3 o'clock the green curtain went up with Greg Abbott, riding for Northwest Honda, grabbing the holeshot and leading the first wave into turn one. When the leaders came by for lap one, Northwest was in third behind the Noble Knights and Team TSBA. On lap two, Robert Marsh turned on the TSBA afterburners and began to leave everybody in the dust. The bike he was riding was not your ordinary 600 Kawasaki. This was the same exact ZX-6 that Miguel Duhamel had just rode to victory at the 600 Supersport race in Daytona just one week ago. Quick thinking Steve Tice was the first to exercise the AMA's new claiming rule and obtained the Muzzy built machine for only \$7800. It was a screaming deal, at least until lap 12 when

machine abruptly spit Robert off the highside in turn seven.

That incident promoted Northwest Honda into the lead and the race stabilized with Plano Honda 15 seconds behind and holding. Lone Star held third but was slowly giving up ground.

Lone Star was the first of the front runners to pit, coming in at the 55 minute mark on lap 36. That put them a lap down and let C&C (Chad Bynum and Chet Meyer) into third place. Plano pitted quickly on lap 39. Northwest Honda stopped three laps later but the pit work was not as good and they found themselves in second place. Vintage Five Champion Ronnie Lunsford tried his best but couldn't catch the Plano entry, now being piloted by Formula Two Champion Damon Harvey. Plano went on to win by half a lap (the checkered flag fell between them, giving Plano credit for one more). Lone Star held on for third, the only other team still on the "lead" lap.

In Class Action, Keith Leschber's Blackfire Racing Team held off a determined assault from Blitz (Stan Funkhouser & Bruce Norris) to win Mediumweight Production while in the Lightweights, X-Racing (David Krenek & Aaron Obenberger) left the Null Set, Loud Racing, and the Gremlins to squabble over second. Godspeed Racing (Jeff and Chris Normand) topped the Heavy Produce division.

It was a good race, but the short distance didn't really provide a good test of endurance. With a six hour next on the schedule, the "real" endurance teams should be able to show their stuff. Plano is fast, but are they "real". Stay tuned.

ATTITUDE CARVES ANOTHER NOTCH

They're baa-aack. Attitude Racing's Tommy Hickman and Barbie Spears are teamed up again and gunning for their fourth straight YSR Superbike Endurance title. In brutally cold conditions, they out-ran and out-lasting 21 other teams to take the overall victory in the first round of the series. The Legends were second and Atomic Fireball took third, first in the hotly contested Production class.

The sun was out for the 9:00am start, but it provided little relief from the 30 degree temperature or the relentless 20 mph "breeze". Greg Mesa (riding for Action Sports) led the first lap, followed by the Backmarkers Stanley Huffman, Attitudes Tommy Hickman, and Atomic Fireballers Mark Gerow. The Action Sports machine had plenty of muscle and Mesa used it to pull away from the three way fight for second. Stanley Huffman slowly escaped from the fracas to a safe second until crashing on lap seven. Hickman and Gerow were the only ones having any fun in the frigid conditions as they now battled for second instead of third.

The race continued in this manner until lap 12 when Action Sports machine started sounding funny and their lead began to shrink. By lap 17, the lead was gone and Action pitted to repair a pinched fuel line. That left Attitude (who had finally subdued Atomic Fireball) with the lead and they held it past the halfway mark.

Race Director Johnny Hodgkiss boarded the now healthy Action Sports machine and began picking up huge chunks of ground on the leader. The charge carried him to the front on lap 40, and the only question now was could the team owner, Ray Anderson, hold it as he prepared to ride the last 12 laps. We'll never know, as the exhaust pipe broke just after Ray got on. They spent four laps in the pits for repairs and limped to the finish.

That left Attitude to clean up the race, quietly followed by The Legends, who had never fallen off the lead lap. Atomic Fireball finished in third overall, first in the Production class. Brrr.

CLUB NEWS

We had a good turn-out at the first race. In spite of the bad weather forecast, we had 22 in the YSR endurance, 24 in the riders school, and 43 entries in the big bike endurance. On Sunday we had 491 entries in spite of giving refunds to several riders whos bikes froze.

The riders school planned for Aug 21 at Hallett has been cancelled. The Hallett Roadracing Club (HRC) is now a WERA affiliate and there appears to be no need for CMRA to run a school up there on that date. The endurance race for that date is still scheduled for five hours.

Motels in the Texas World Area are booked up solid for our April 17-18 event because of "Parents Day". No camping will be available at the track on Friday night. They don't even want you to pull up to the gate before six in the morning on Saturday. Camping is available at the track on Saturday night for an \$8 fee. Motorhomes will be charged \$15 per day.

At a CMRA Board meeting on March 13th, the CMRA's liberal refund policy was modified. From now on, whenever the track is wet, we will revert to the WERA rulebook refund policy which states; "There will be no refunds once the bike has been through tech."

The WERA Pro event at Moroso had to be cancelled because of flooding. CMRA racer Kenneth Cleveland got a double dose of bad luck when his truck and trailer (with all his equipment) was stolen from the motel parking lot at the cancelled event. If anyone hears of any information that could lead to the recovery of Kenneth's equipment, they are urged to call the club office.

Micky Hunt sent in a press release outlining TV coverage of Roadracing for the '93 season. There's going to be a lot of it, mostly (entirely) on ESPN and Prime Network. Space and time prevent listing it all here and now. Check your local listings starting April 8th.

Fans of racing in Mexico will be interested to know that the CMRA recieved a schedule from them listing an event at Saltillo on May 23rd. It's listed as an F3 event which translates to "Open class only" run between car events. Good luck.

Registration reports that the entry forms are not being filled out completely. Here are some tips; If your bike is both an endurance and a sprint bike, you need two tech forms. Treat it like two bikes and label one form endurance and one sprint. Ditto if you are using two numbers on one bike for sprints - get two tech forms and treat it like two bikes. If you haven't filled out your tech form from the boxes up, don't get into the tech line. Run your assigned number. If you don't, your grid position will suffer and you will be charged a \$5 fee for each entry. Racers who wish to participate in the many

contingency programs available are responsible for correctly and completely filling out the releases and tech forms. Incomplete forms will result in non payment. Endurance teams who wish to recieve points must list the team owner, team captain, and V.I.N. of the race bike(s). The five rider limit applies, teams that list a sixth rider will start over in points. CMRA limits endurance teams to two bikes for practice purposes both V.I.N. numbers must be listed on the entry forms. Endurance teams that go to their second frame in the race must have a pit marshal witness and record the time of the emergence of the second machine into the race. Failure to do so will result in fines to the team owner.

Several racers were docked at the last race for rolling the start. The CMRA's policy is simple; don't move before the flag. Also, while we are griping, some racers are not attending the riders meetings. These meetings are mandatory for all riders. Also, watch your pit bike behavior at TWS. Remember, all pit bikes must have number plates bearing the resposable riders number.

On Saturday, cold pit road must be cleared of vehicles by the time of the riders meeting. On Sunday, no vehicles are allowed on cold pit road. TWS wants us to hurry up and complete our racing program on time so they can release some of their personel. Try not to hold up the program if you can help it (i.e. don't oil the track).
