TY HOWARD GRABS WIN ON LAST LAP

Taking advantage of a couple of late race breaks, Texan Ty Howard managed to come up with a surprise win in round one of the Red River Challenge, a race that seemed, until the end, to be under the control of Mississippi's Joshua Hayes. Oklahoma's Rick Kirk finished a solid third, followed by Rookie of the Year candidate Cass Cooper and Georgia rider Chris Caylor. In Novice action, Steven McBride and Jeremy Keller led a Texas sweep of the top six positions while Arkansas' Jean-Jacques Poux, Louisiana's Lee Fugler, and Tennessee's Owen Reid had the best out-of-state finishes.

The Red River Challenge, now in its fourth year, has evolved into a six race series of medium distance sprint races. There are cash purses to both Novice and Expert and Championships are awarded to both the top Texas as well as out-of-state riders. Excellent spring-time weather conditions contributed to a huge turn-out - over 70 entries in the Novice division - and two 8 lap elimination heat races were scheduled, with the top 20 from each heat transferring to the 16 lap main. The 45 Experts would all run together in one 28 lap race - or at least, that was the initial plan.

In heat one, Jeremy Keller got by early leader Ty Howard leads Josh Hayes in the Red River Challenge. Rick Howard on lap one

and held off Steven McBride for the win. Ron Rippe was third until crashing on the last lap, elevating T.J. Patel and Rick Howard.

Of particular interest was ride of #797 Stewart Goddard, who hails from La Canada California. Goddard is a paraplegic who rides a specially modified Honda RS125. His lower extremities are held in place by velcro and he is assisted at the start and again at the finish by a crew member. Starting from the back of the second wave, Stewart managed to pass 13 riders in 8 laps and came within 3 positions of qualifying

The Expert race was set for 28 laps and featured 45 of the fastest riders from both in and out of Texas. The Texans

were led by defending Champion Ty Howard, who was backed up by John Haner and Pete Martins. Josh Hayes and Rick Kirk looked to be the biggest threats from the Rest of the World. On the start, Ty Howard jumped into the lead but was quickly hauled down by Josh Hayes. Hayes took the lead on lap two and then turned a 1:26.72, a pace that nobody could match. Howard accepted second place while Rick Kirk lurked around in third. Big John Haner was the man on the move, passing Marcus McBain on lap two, Rick Kirk on lap three, and on lap six he passed Ty

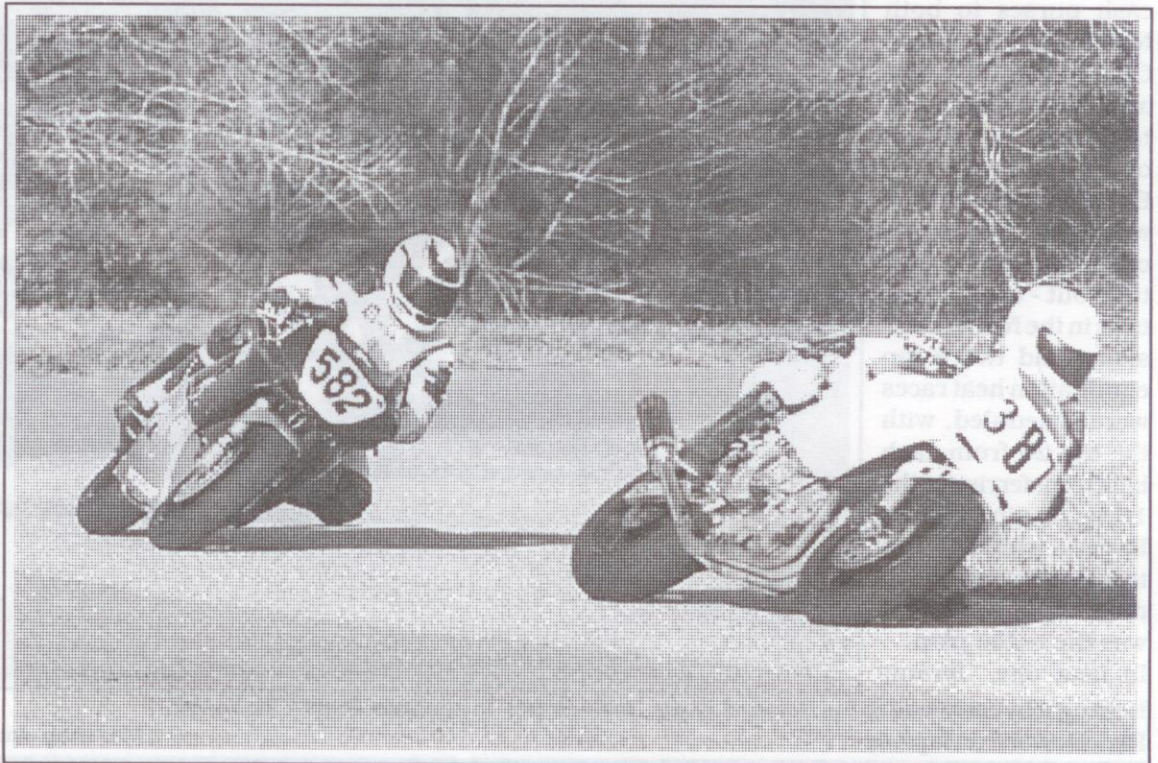
for the main event. Very impressive.

Riding the ex-Shawn Subt #459 ZX6, Joseph Edwards won the second heat followed by David Cook. The next four positions were filled by Matt Watson, Scott Foster, Richard Pullian, and Kevin Pate, all of whom started from the second wave.

In the main event, scheduled for 16 laps, Joseph Edwards led the first lap followed by Jeremy Keller, TJ Patel, Scott Foster, and Steven McBride. Keller took the lead on lap 4 and held it until lap 7, when Steven McBride arrived at the front. Steve turned a 1:30.44 on lap 9 and pulled away, eventually padding his lead to six seconds at the finish. Keller held on for second, followed by Edwards and Foster. David Cook rounded out the top five.

Howard for second place.

While the leaders looked set, the rest of the race was nothing less than a riot as massive battles were fought all around the

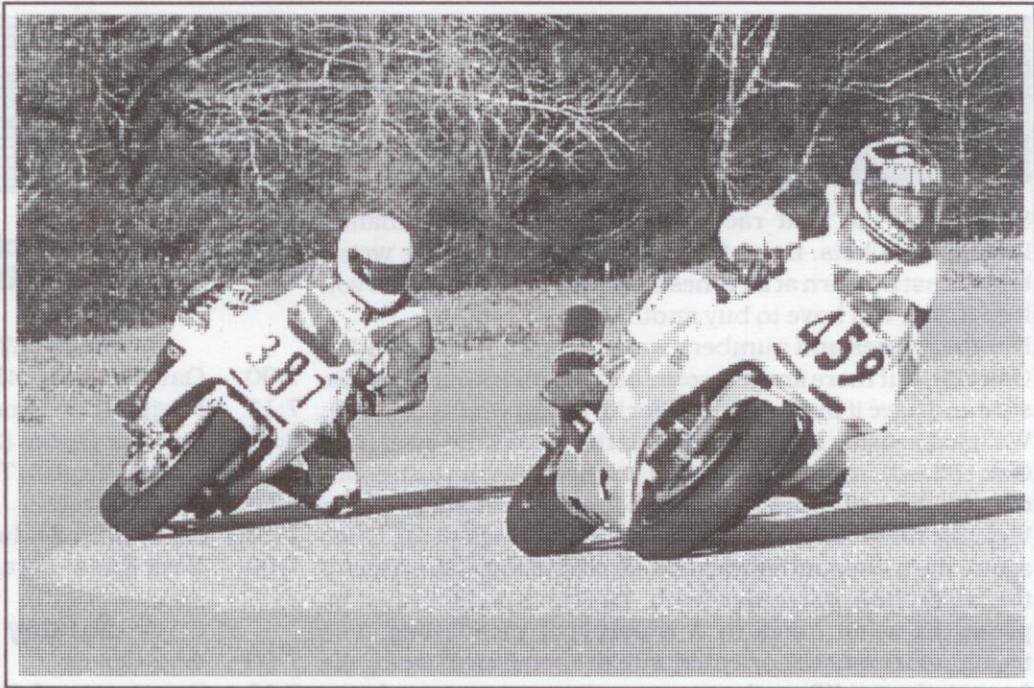


#387 Jeremy Keller leads eventual winner #582 Steven McBride.

track. Then on lap 10, the race was suddenly stopped for a crash involving Shawn Subt, who had high-sided as he exited the school house turn. Officials dictated a 10 lap remainder, with new grid positions determined by current running order.

The break gave Ty Howard a chance to make much needed adjustments, and the new and improved Ty Howard jumped out in front on the re-start. Hayes, robbed of his hard fought lead, was forced to work his way forward and it took several laps to reach a striking position on Howard. Meanwhile John Haner, who was back into third place, crashed in turn one. John was un-hurt, but he was also very unhappy at having thrown away a sure third place. Back at the front, Hayes made a couple of pass attempts, but was rejected as a desperate Ty Howard tried to hold onto the lead. Hayes re-grouped and attacked again in turn two. This time, he was successful and the lead once again belonged to the Mississippi Madman. This time though, Howard did not give up and stayed within range, even when Hayes dipped into the 26's. On the white

flag lap, it was still advantage Hayes - until they caught a couple of lapped riders in turn six. "I got by the first one, but the second one stuck me and Ty went around the outside," said Hayes after the race. Kirk finished third, Cass Cooper fourth, and Chris Caylor fifth.

CLUB NEWS

Starting at the next race, we will be using wristbands instead of tickets. Do not lose your wristband. The wristband must be worn at all times for the entire weekend. If you lose it, you will have to buy another.

Number plates and numbers were somewhat improved at Oak Hill, but there are still some bad numbers out there. Be sure and have it fixed at Texas World, or you won't pass tech. We tried scoring some races with the electronic system at Oak Hill with mixed results. We learned that the transponder must be mounted correctly for the system to work. Wearing them inside the leathers did not work at all. Once again, the transponder must be carried in a pouch on top of the tail section, not underneath. The transponder must be protected at all times by a waterproof plastic bag. The transponder must be oriented with the small ends facing the front and rear. When the transponders are mounted correctly, the signals are uniform and it allows us to set the sensitivity of the receiver better. The transponders need to be turned in immediately following the race. We might be scoring some more big novice races at Texas World, so ATTENTION all you 600cc - 750cc novices, its time to mount the pouch.

Practice for endurance races is usually split into 3 groups: Novice, Expert, and transponder only. If your team has both Novices and Experts, and your bike has a white plate, then let the Experts use it in the Expert session and let the Novices run the transponder only group.

Hot pit road is considered part of the racetrack during an endurance race - NOT IN PRACTICE. All machines entering the track for practice must do so at pit out and be checked by a pit marshal before entering the track. Texas World is blessed with an exceptionally wide cold pit road, so we do allow trucks and trailers to park against the fence. DO NOT, even temporarily, stop your vehicle in the middle of cold pit road. Cold pit road must be double wide clear at all times.

COMPETITION HEAVY AT HENDERSON

It was standing room only at Oak Hill Raceway as hundreds of roadracers showed up for round two of the CMRA's Championship Sprint Series. The race was sanctioned as a cross-over event by WERA, and that, along with more great springtime weather, led to a record breaking turn-out of over 600 entries. No one rider was able to dominate the event but Josh Hayes and Rick Kirk tied for top honors with two wins each. With 22 races on tap, the action got underway at 10:30 and didn't stop until the cows came home.

Race #1 - Formula 80/Super 80/Super 50/Classic Light
The new Moriwaki 80s showed their stuff in the new Formula 80 class, finishing 1-2 as Preston Landers squeezed by Michael Kent at mid-race and held on for the win. Landers fastest lap was a 1:44.81, almost half a second quicker than Eric Kancir's Super 80 track record of 1:45.35. Perry Caruso won Super 80 ahead of Chris Newhouse and Darin Cooley while Jay Deaton took Super 50 ahead of Glen Massengill and Freddy Haltom.

Race #2 - Heavyweight/Lightweight Superbike
With almost 40 entries, the Provisional Novice race was split into two and Dale Love, from Haltom City, ran away with the Heavyweight division from David Lang and Anthony Bishop. Barry Robbins was the Lightweight winner over Carroll Dase and Missouri's William Tolbert.

Race #3 - Mediumweight Superbike

The 600 Prov Nov race was a wide open affair as Jason Jones jumped out in front and led for the first 4 laps before crashing out. Gene Holiday then took over and was credited with the fastest lap at 1:36.34. His glory, like most prov novs, was short-lived as he crashed out also, leaving Paul Pardon to take the checkered flag ahead of Don Harward and Dudley Irby. The top three all came from the second wave.

Race #4 - Production 50

Chuck Ergle and Randy Robinette picked up where they left off last year as they traded the lead every lap, with Ergle coming out on top on the last lap. Freddy Haltom earned third place ahead of Carlton Tanner and Bobby Slater. Troy Masure was your Novice

winner after Carlos Lopez was disqualified for running a blatantly illegal exhaust system. Masure was followed home by Russ Corley and Joe Chatham.

Race #5 - C Production / Vintage 5

Still dialed in from his victory the day before in the Red River Challenge, Steven McBride was able to pull away and win the C Production race by 6 seconds. Jeremy Keller had a tougher time of it, working his way forward from a second wave start to place second overall ahead of Richard Pulliam. Scott Foster and Paul Mitchell rounded out the top 5. In Vintage 5, it was the old veteran, W. David Cheek, who used the horsepower of his CB750F to hold off the surprisingly quick SR500 Yamaha of Chris Fox.

Race #6 - C Superstock / Heavyweight Twins Expert / Vintage 6

The first big Showdown of the Superstars came in race #6 as Ty Howard and Rick Kirk lined up on the front row with Josh Hayes and Chris Rankin back on row 7 and 8. Ty Howard nailed the start, dipped down into the 26s on lap 3, and was able to open up some breathing room on Rick Kirk, who followed in second. Paul Bordelon made his usual aggressive start and held third until being displaced by Georgia rider Chris Caylor. Meanwhile Chris Rankin was

second wave start to finish second. James Rudd came up with third, followed by Jean-jaques Poux and Richard Pulliam.

Race #9 - B Superstock

This race looked good on the grid sheet but did not produce the fireworks expected of it. For one thing, Kirk was a non-starter and Ty Howard's Suzuki was not hooking up like his Kawasaki. The result was that no one was able to challenge Josh Hayes as he ran away with a five second victory. There were some surprises however including Cass Cooper, who held off Chris Rankin for second, and Rodney Smith who passed Pete Martins on the last lap for fourth.

Race #10 - Lightweight Twins / Formula RD / Formula 500

Ben Spies, Ryan Landers and Ryan Smith dominated the Lightweight Twins race with their Honda RS125s. Spies fastest lap was almost half a second quicker than Scott Dennis' class record. Eric

Falt had the best finish on a bike that was actually a twin with third place. After the race, the Twins riders were up in arms and preparing a petition to WERA to eliminate F3 machines. In Vintage, Formula 500 drew five entries and was won by Chris Fox, followed at some distance by Dennis Tackett and Michael Langley.

making his way through the field and by mid-race had passed Bordelon and Caylor for third. That was as far as he got however, and the race ended with Howard still leading ahead of Kirk, Rankin, Caylor, Hayes, and Bordelon. Scott Crews rode a Suzuki TL1000 to the win in the Heavyweight Twins segment, followed by Rob Bradlaw on a Honda VTR1000 and Eric Falt on another Suzuki. In Vintage 6, Danny Dominguez finished first on his 600 Katana ahead of W. David Cheek.

Race #7 - Clubman / Heavyweight Twins Novice / Vintage 3

Finishing positions were set on lap one of the Clubman race as Eric Falt ran away from Bruce Moore and Laroy Montgomery. Philip Davies might have been a factor but crashed on the second lap. Chris Fox finished a surprising fourth overall on his V3 winning SR500 while Bryan Whitton won Heavyweight Twins. In Clubman Novice, the winner was Tom Melesky, followed by Allen Crosby and Barry Robbins.

Race #8 - B Production

Joseph Edwards jumped out in front and led half of the B Production race, but then crashed in turn 4. Steven McBride took over from there while Jeremy Keller worked his way up from another

Race #11 - B Superbike Novice

With 48 entries and a three wave start, the safest place to be was out in front in the B Superbike race, and that's where the winner Chris Robinson stayed. Chris Munoz followed for second while Jeremy Keller was once again forced to work his way up from a second wave start. T. J. Patel and Jean-Jaques Poux rounded out the top five.

Race #12 - B Superbike Expert

Ty Howard had his Suzuki working better, good enough in fact to lead most of the B Superbike race, but it was no match for Rick Kirk on the Blevins Paint and Body ZX7. Kirk took his time working his way up and arrived at the front on lap seven, and then sealed the victory with a 1:26.65 - the fastest lap of the weekend. Howard was second and

Jordan Ransom was a surprising third ahead of Pete Martins.

Race #13 - 125 GP/Vintage 4/Formula 2 Stroke/Vintage 2

The young guns met again in 125GP, but it was not the runaway for Ben Spies like it had been in Lightweight Twins. In fact, Ryan Landers put the pressure on, passed for the lead on lap 6, and was looking like the winner until running off in turn 6 and crashing. The bottom line had Spies in first followed at some distance by Ryan Smith and

Jody Hudson. Chris Fox won again in V4 while Fred Beck and Peter Pohlman disputed second and third. Barry Robbins picked up the F2 stroke victory as did Dennis Tackett in V2.

Race #14 - Open Superbike Expert

Once again, Rick Kirk and the Blevins ZX7 proved too much for Ty Howard in the Open Superbike feature race. Howard led two laps before Kirk got by and was gone. Pete Martins held off Rodney Smith for third while Josh Hayes had a problematic ride for fifth.

Race #15 - Formula One Novice

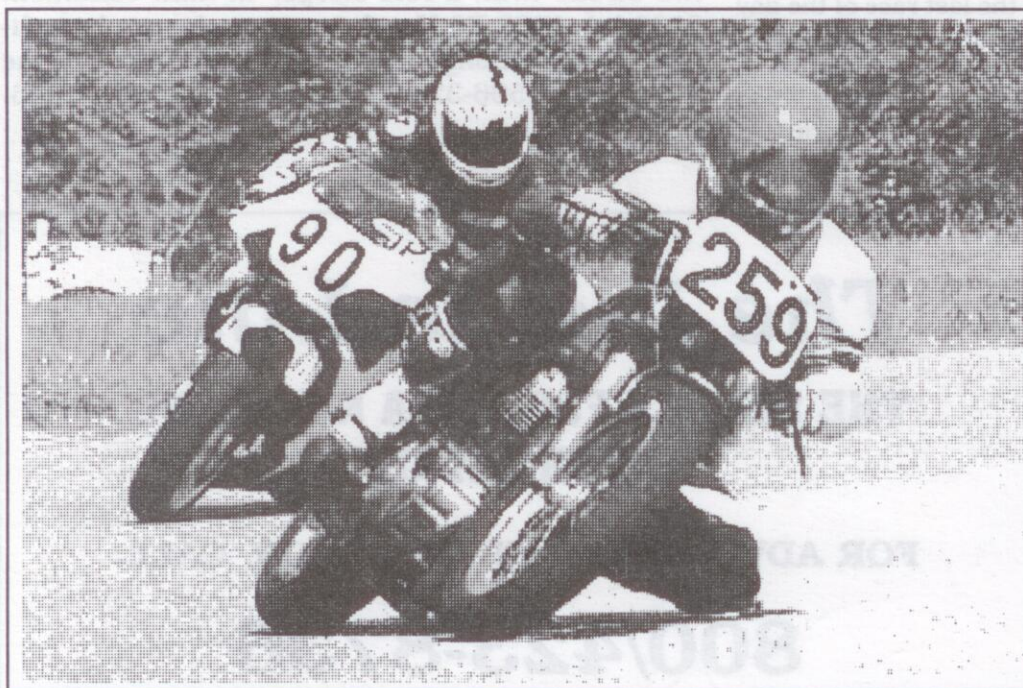
Richard Pulliam got the good start and led half the F1 Novice race before Jeremy Keller arrived to take over on lap 5. T. J. Patel held second while Pulliam faded to fourth behind Chris Munoz.

Race #16 - Formula Two

Ryan Landers ran away with the 250 GP race, turning a 1:28.6 on the way to a 9 second margin of victory. Shayne Ellis pried second place away from Ben Spies, who was on his 125 as were Ryan Smith and Jody Hudson. In the Novice division, David Bowen won ahead of Jimmy Wyble and Patrick Sweetland.

Race #17 - C Superbike Novice

Last year it was Cass Cooper and Shawn Subt. This year Jeremy Keller and Steven McBride are emerging as the Novices to beat. Keller won this particular show-

down, with McBride second, and Scott Foster third.

Race #18 - C Superbike Expert

The way Ty Howard jumped out in front of this race, it seemed impossible that anyone could catch him - but someone did. James Schaefer, the wily veteran, steadily tracked him down and topped it off with a race winning pass on the the last corner of the last lap that left Howard fit to be tied. Chris Caylor, the rider from Smyrna Georgia, took third ahead of Rodney Smith and Jeremy Saathoff.

Race #19 - A Superstock

Usually, first year experts have a tough time making the transition to the next level, but it hasn't been that way for Cass Cooper. Coop took the lead away from Pete Martins on lap 3 and turned a 1:26.97 before being relieved by Josh Hayes on lap 6. Hayes went on to win with Cooper second and Martins third. Perry Braxmire and Jordan Ransom rounded out the top 5.

Race #20 - D Superbike

Oklahoma rider Danny Dominguez led the first lap with his Katana but was swallowed up by Randy White's Ducati on lap 2. Wesley Wiese kept White company for the rest of the race while Scott Dennis got past Bruce Moore and Danny Dominguez on the last lap to take third. Jimmy Wyble was the Novice winner ahead of Allen Crosby and Patrick Sweetland.

Race #21 - Open Superbike Novice

After running near the front all day, T. J. Patel recorded his first win by holding off Steven McBride for 8 laps. Scott Foster was third ahead of William Cotton and Jean-Jaques Poux.

Race #22 - Formula One Expert

The shadows were getting long as the last race of the day rolled up to the grid. Held win-less all day, Pete Martins grabbed the lead in a determined fashion, but Cooper took the lead on lap 2 and ran away to a 10 second victory. Ryan Landers made a run at Martins late in the race but crashed on the last lap and Andy Galindo got third.

YSR EXPRESS RULES ROUND ONE

The YSR Express opened up the CMRA's mini-bike endurance season with a convincing four lap victory. Chuck Ergle and Eric Kancir had a trouble free run aboard Thomas Hoover's RM80 powered YSR, accumulating a total of 66 laps in the two hour period. Chris Newhouse and Andy Yim bought Ray Anderson's Super 80 machine in the off season and rode it to second place under the Ray's Electric banner. Third overall went to Jay Deaton and Darin Cooley, who were Takin' Care of Business.

Bright sunshine and cool temperatures were the order of the day as the YSR Endurance Series prepared to kick off the CMRA's 1998 racing season. The start came at 9:01 with PK Racing taking the lead on a very fast (and very loud) 80cc YSR. Meanwhile Chuck Ergle worked the YSR Express steadily to the front and took over the lead on lap 8. Last year's champions, the Geezers on Wheezers, found themselves challenged by Ray's Electric for third place. The battle heated up and carried them past PK Racing, who's exhaust system was steadily disintegrating.

The first hour came with the Express still rolling with 32 laps while the Wheezers and Ray's Electric were one lap down after having already made their pit stops. In Super 50, DDR finally emerged with the lead ahead of Team Jesus, RNR, and JCJ. The Crash Dummies were out after doing well initially. In Production, Last Minute was shown with the lead after the dominate WRW team pitted at about the 45 minute mark. Kitty Flinger was second, WRW third, and Paint Shack fourth - all 4 teams on the same lap.

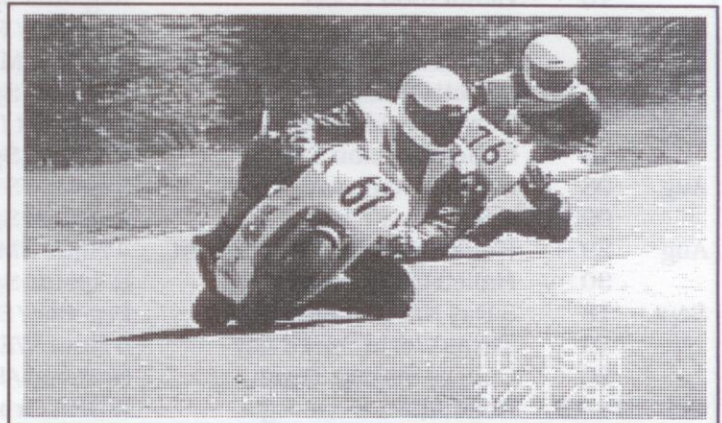
The YSR Express pitted just after the hour, with Eric Kancir taking over from Chuck Ergle. The stop was smooth and they were quickly back on track with fuel and fresh exhaust bailing wire. They continued all the way to the checkered flag while Ray's Electric and the Geezers were hampered by difficulties that left them in second and fifth place respectively. Takin' Care of Business finished third overall ahead of DSR/Honda of Houston. In Super 50, RNR took over the lead from Team Jesus with just 10 laps to go while DDR faded to third. In Production, WRW overcame Last Minutes and Paint Shack while Kitty Flinger fell to fourth last, and very possibly least, the Cherry Pickers won the new Formula 80 class against minimal opposition (as in none).

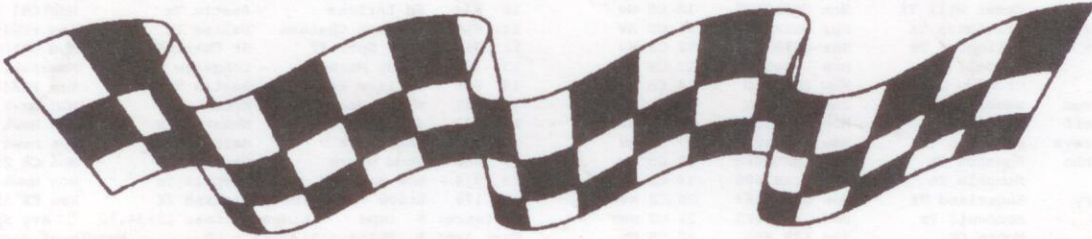
