HARRELSON HAMMERS HENDERSON HOMEBOYS

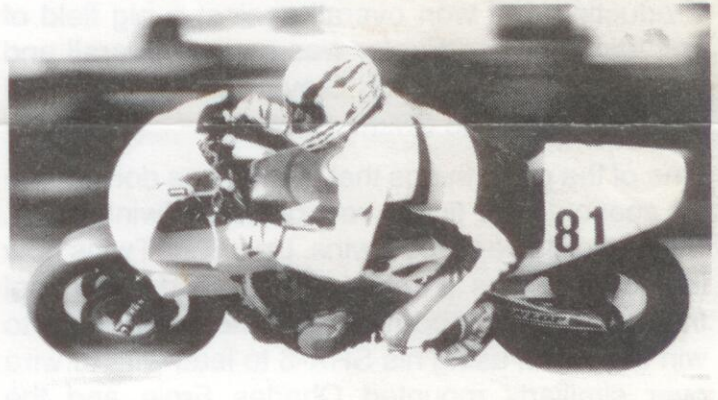
Brett Harrelson, Colin Edwards, and Danny Walker all had reasons to smile at the CMRA's home opener at Oak Hill Raceway. Harrelson used his CBR600F2 to win every race he entered, taking first place in C & B Superstock and C & B Superbike. Colin Edwards, fresh from his big 250 win at Daytona, won the Formula Two race and trimmed another six tenths from his track record (which now stands at 1:26.09). And Colorado's Danny Walker (who now lives in Denton) recorded one of the rare defeats of Colin Edwards in the Formula One rematch late in the day.

Perfect weather contributed to the huge turn-out (479 entries) and the pits were practically bursting with racers and want to be's. The first race featured the Three Brothers Racing Team as micro sized Roger Lee Hayden joined his mini sized brothers Tommy and Nicky on the Production 50 grid. This time it was Nicky who won (wire to wire) ahead of Tommy Hickman and Jay Deaton. In the Novice division, Craig Waugh took first with Chris Reed second and Darin Cooley third.

C Superstock was a wide open, knock down drag out brawl and earned the honor of race of the day. At the front, Jeb Bridgeman, Larry Locklear, Taizo Hatakeyama, and Brett Harrelson rammed and jammed each other so hard you could see broken bodywork flying as far as turn two. It would take a video camera to give a blow by blow account but in the final analysis, Harrelson's strategy of letting the others knock each other silly worked the best. He took over on lap six and used a lapped rider to dislodge himself from Locklear on the next to last lap, with Robie McGonagill improving to third. It was a fine example of what sprint racing is all about, with very high talent levels throughout the

field.

C Production saw experts Robie McGonagill and Matt Zhorne avoid embarrassment by a slew of Novices and Provisional Novices. Toby Grace was third overall and won the Novice division ahead of Steven Isenhower and Lee Fugler. Provisional Novices Charlie Brown, Todd Driggers, and Greg Howard came in sixth, seventh, and eighth overall, despite having started in the second wave.

The Road Warrior class (now known as Formula Clubman) was won by Doug Carmichael, who passed early leader Joey Raborn's SRX-6 at the halfway flag and showed that, in the right hands, the Honda RS 125 is fully competitive. Tommy Hayden brought another RS home in third. Jim Beedle rode his Kawasaki to the Novice win ahead of Bruce Moore and Micah Stevenson.

Greg Abbott debuted his new Kawasaki ZX-7R in the B Superstock race, powering his way into an early lead ahead of Locklear, Hatakeyama, McBain, Bridgeman, and Harrelson. As the halfway

flag was being shown, the race was stopped so the ambulance could examine John Havener who had crashed approaching turn two. (John was transported and held overnight for observation of a concussion and a broken collarbone). As only three laps had been completed, the race was restarted as a five lapper, with a new grid sheet reflecting the running order after three laps. On the restart, Hatakeyama aggressively jumped out in front but was soon passed by Harrelson. Taizo crashed in turn two on the second lap, and perhaps due to his limited understanding of English, failed to obey the corner workers and immediately rejoined the race. Before he could be black flagged he crashed again, this time in turn one. Meanwhile at the front, it looked like Abbott had Harrelson in his gun sights, but as the race wound down, Harrelson just went faster. On the white flag lap, Brett uncorked a 1:28.38, bettering the class record by over a second. Abbott took second with Jeb Bridgeman third.

Matt Zhorne was the only expert entered in B Production and won overall against a big field of fast learners. Lee Fugler was second overall and first Novice, ahead of Steven Isehower and Provisional Novice Charlie Brown.

One of the good things that WERA has done in the off season is to finally recognize a Twins class. Similar to Battle of the Twins, Unlimited Twins now includes Singles and two strokes. Riders School Instructor Joey Raborn showed the correct way to win the class, using his SRX-6 to lead wire to wire over similiarly mounted Charles Egle and the Hawk of Tim Barnes. In the Novice class, TSBA Secretary Scott Dennis took top honors with David Metcalf second and Robert Higgenbotham third.

Brett Harrelson and Greg Abbott locked horns again in B Superbike. Brett turned a couple of '38s to lead but slowed to '39s as Abbott closed up late in the race. On the last lap Abbott went by on the brakes into turn two but Harrelson immediately dove under Greg as they drove out, and then managed to get by some lapped traffic that Greg could not. Larry Locklear was third. Lee Fugler topped the big Novice field, this time ahead of Walker Alford and Charlie Brown.

Tech Inspector Robert Marsh led the D Production race all the way while little known Jim Selitto of Shreveport slipped by Keith Leschber for second. In the Novice division, Sharon Earthman made the transition from YSR50 to FZR400 with surprising ease. She won her first time out, out-running Gary Allen and Steve Tice among many others.

A Superbike was all Gordon Miller, as he used his front row starting position to jump to an early lead and was never contested. Michael Myers took full control of second as did Robie McGonagill in third. Novice wise, it was Charlie Brown over Don Hodges and Charlie Dill.

Tommy Hickman wound up as the meat in a Hayden sandwich in Super 50. Tommy Hayden won, Hickman was second, and Nicky was third. (It's a good thing Hickman doesn't have a little brother named Nicky). In the Novices, Jason Glynn emerged victorious over Chriss Reed and John Etheridge.

Many were eagerly looking forward to the Formula Two race, as Colin Edwards and Danny Walker were sure to set a record breaking pace. The grid was a scary sight to the officials, as the extremely potent pair of Edwards and Walker, due to their late sign up order, were back on row seven. As the green flag flew, Edwards wasted no time, hurtling through traffic in an awesome display of riding skill. Before the first lap had even been completed, Colin was in front and flying. A lot of stopwatches were on Colin as he completed lap two and the official clock showed a new track record of 1:26.51. On lap three, he lowered it again to 1:26.09. Then, as he encountered lapped traffic, he seemed to back off a little and set the cruise for 1:27. Few had seen how Danny Walker had almost matched Edwards pace and on the last few laps, Danny had quietly slipped into range if Edwards had made any mistake, but he made none. Michael Myers slipped Jim Sabin at the white flag for third. In the

Novice division, Gregory Fowler was credited with the win (finally) over William Comegys and David Metcalf.

Brett Harrelson won his fourth race of the day in C Superbike, leading all the way although Larry Locklear got close a couple of times. It seemed that everytime Larry would get within striking range he would get distracted or Brett would get a break in traffic or something. The race for third place was excellent between Jeb Bridgeman, Mark Black, and Robie McGonagill. This trio of second year experts spent all last year racing one another and are often found clumped together. This time Bridgeman got the trophy. Lee Fugler won his third race of the day in AP Novice, topping Toby Grace and Steven Isenhower.

The A Superstock / Production race got off to a shaky start when several bikes in the second wave went down at the start finish line. Ron Noble appeared to get the worst of it, but thankfully was not injured as badly as it first seemed. The remaining races were shortened to six laps as the shadows began to grow. Greg Abbott took off on the restart and won while Gordon Miller slipped past Jeb Bridgeman about mid race for second. In the Novices, Walker Alford won his first race, besting Charlie Brown and Todd Driggers.

Bryan Hanson defended his D Superbike National Championship in fine style, placing his #1 plate equipped FZR400 into the top spot. Robert Marsh held Kelly Moody at bay for second. In DS Novice, Gregory Fowler won his second race of the day, finishing well ahead of Scott Dennis and William Comegys.

In Vintage action, Chris Cook took his rare Ducati 450 single to the V2 victory over Charles Statman's not so rare Honda 175. In Vintage Four, Triumph mounted Keith Martin took first over the Suzuki Titan of David Hirsch and the Morini of Jerry Hubbard. In V3 it was much the same except Hirsch put up a much better struggle, even leading one of the middle laps. The V5 win went to the Seca 550 of Tracy LeBlanc, who surprised the 750 Hondas of W David Cheek and Eddie Carver.

Greg Abbott led the first lap of Formula One, but as in Formula Two, Colin Edwards quickly made his way to the front, turned a 1:26.48, and again put it on cruise. And again, Danny Walker fought past Michael Myers and Jim Sabin and stelhily crept up behind Edwards and waited for a mistake. On the last lap it happened. In turn three, Colin came up on his sponser, Erich Klementich. Instead of automatically stuffing him, like he probably would have anyone else, Colin hesitated and Erich turned into the corner, blocking Colin's line and killing his drive. Walker was on him in a heartbeat, and in turn seven, expertly applied the stuff pass. Edwards desparately tried to retailiate in turn eight but Walker defended his line and the upset was sealed. Immediately after the race, Edwards was understandably upset, but he'll get over it. As Doug Polen once said after a similar occurance, "There'll be another day, and there'll be another race". And Colin will be much tougher to sneak up on next time. In the Walker camp and throughout the rest of the pits as well, there was a well earned celebration. It was a great day at the races.

TEAM BEAST WINS BIG

Team Beast owner Andy East finally got what he's been wanting for a long time; an overall win. It came in the first round of the CMRA's 1992 Endurance Series. Under perfect racing conditions, riders Bryan Hanson and Pete Martins combined to turn 59 laps and top a turn away field that had to be limited to 47 teams.

At 3:16, the first attempt at a start was red flagged when a turn three chain reaction crash left oil on the track. Clean up took 27 minutes. Ironman was one of the victims, with their GSXR750 unable to continue. As he had in the first start, Razor Razor's Fred Provis jumped into the lead but was soon overhauled by N2 Racing's Jim Sabin. N2's lead lasted for only one lap, as the clutch mechanism started making ominous noises and they retired. That promoted Team TSBA into first on lap five and Mark Black held the lead until lap 14 when Brett Harrelson went by, riding for Southwest Motorsports. As with many teams, Southwest was really just using the Endurance race as an opportunity to

test and dial in their equipment. Harrelson pulled in while leading on lap 21, giving the lead back to TSBA. One lap later, Team Beast rider Bryan Hanson passed for the lead and opened up some breathing room.

After 30 laps, Beast had enough room that they were able to make their pit stop and still hold the lead (barely) from Razor Razor. By the time Razor and the others had made their stops, Beast had almost a lap lead and was able to hold it to the finish. The Noble Knights started well with Jeb Bridgeman and went even better with Marcus McBain aboard, improving from fifth to second overall, and first in Heavyweight Production. TSBA held on for third overall (1st HWS) and HSR Endurance (with the Hipsher Brothers, Todd Jensen and ex-motocrosser Kent Howerton) took fourth overall, first MWP. First place in the lightweight class went to Harvey Racing's Sharon Earthman and Damon Harvey. The next stop is Texas World Speedway.

ATTITUDE WINS GOING AWAY

The Attitude Racing Team returned and successfully defended their Superbike Championship at the opening round of the CMRA's YSR Endurance Series. Riders Tommy Hickman and Greg Abbott racked up an even 60 laps and won going away. In the Production class, the win went to the Austin based Atomic Fireball Team of Mark Gerow and Don Bradley.

Eighteen teams gridded for the start and at 9:43 the signal was given. The battle for the lead was a familiar one between Nicky Hayden (riding with his brother Tommy under the Moto Liberty banner) and Attitude's Tommy Hickman. Nicky led for the first five laps but then Hickman went past and Nicky had trouble staying with him. Attitude's lead slowly grew from 10 to 20 and then 30 seconds. At about the 40 minute mark something happened either Hickman slowed or Nicky picked up the

pace because the lead shrank dramatically. And then it went back up again, as an oil leak coated the rear tire and Nicky slid down in turn eight. Nicky picked it up and rode it into his pit, complaining that the rear tire had become "slicker than snot". They took it into the pits for repairs and thus ended any kind of battle for the lead.

When Hickman finally handed over to Greg Abbott, it was well past the one hour mark and all the Superbike trophies were well decided but there was still a good race for second place in Production. At the checkered flag, No BS overcame a slow pit stop to get the nod over the '91 Champs Anonymous. In the Superbike class, Cycle Path (John Etheridge and Bill Comegys) took second with Legends Racing (Chris Reed and Jeff Mark) in third. Next Race May 30th.

CLUB NEWS

The next race will be the CMRA's first at the new Texas World Speedway. We need to be on our best behavior there and be sure not to deface the facility or cause any damage anytime. Among other things, this means; no nails in the asphalt, no pets, no leaning bikes against buildings or walls, no pit bikes, no unattended children, etc. It is not enough that you obey the rules. We must watch out for each other that the facility is taken care of. If you observe anyone doing anything risky, tell them not to or report it immediately to officials or security. They are endangering your privilege to race there (and we don't want to go back to the muddy airport, do we). We must do a good job of cleaning up after ourselves. Put your trash in the barrels. It's important that we make a good impression at our first race with TWS. This race comes under the heading of a "participant event" thus the main

grandstands will not be open nor will the pit road suites (so don't try to go in them). The infield will still be open so enthusiasts may observe what goes on on the track. Photographers are not given any special access to the track and must stay in the same areas as spectators (thus you needn't bother asking for a photo pass). Vendors are strictly controlled and must apply directly to TWS for a permit and be advised that the fees are substantial. We understand that the concession stand will be open. We plan to use the South Tunnel as our entrance gate (but be aware that this could change). The gate will open at 6:00am Saturday morning (no camping Friday night). On Saturday night, you can camp but the gate will be locked from 10:00pm until 6:00am Sunday morning so plan accordingly. Endurance entries will be limited to the first 45 teams that sign up. Any more than that may sign up on a waiting list and will be allowed to enter if other already entered teams

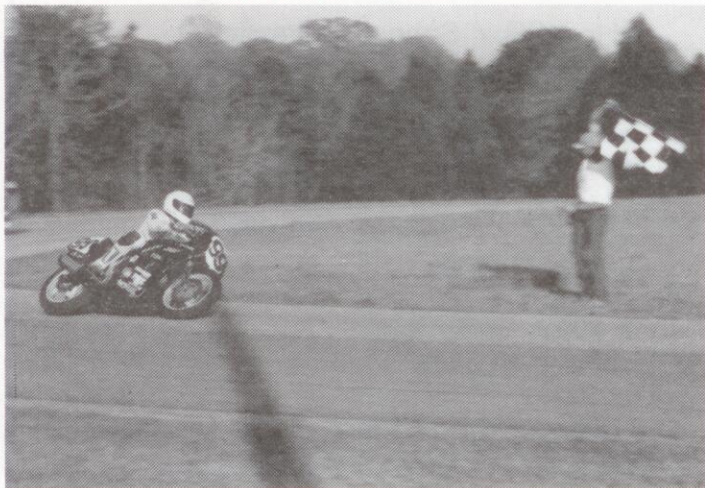

drop out. Teams that wish to drop out must do so before the end of endurance practice and will receive half their entry fee back. Endurance teams must have at least two riders and both must sign the entry form before it will be accepted. CMRA uses a computerized scoring system and high quality number plates showing your teams correct assigned Endurance number are essential. Tech inspection will not pass poor quality numbers. Endurance practice on Saturday morning will be for endurance teams only.

READ CAREFULLY: The sprint races on Sunday will include a cool off lap (this is different from the old days). Practice sessions (and the endurance race) will most likely be ended by a checkered flag in one of the last corners (like at Oak Hill). It is extremely important that you attend all riders meetings whenever they are called. Don't swerve across the track on the start and shut the door on the whole pack. We've had some accidents on the start from this kind of over aggressiveness. Many of our riders have never ridden at TWS and are not used to the high speeds on the banking. Smaller or slower bikes should be very careful not to make a sudden change of direction on the banking. With high speed bikes, if a small bike should suddenly veer into their path, there's not much they can do. Never make a sudden change of direction, especially on a fast part of the track during practice or an endurance race. It would also be a good idea to check your fender clearance and tire balance closely. You'd be surprised how much tires can grow at high speeds, and shake if not balanced.

The 1992 CMRA programs went on sale at Oak Hill and are simply outstanding. If you didn't pick one up at Oak Hill be sure to get one at TWS in the

registration area. Congratulations to Laroy Montgomery for a job well done.

Ruben Loreda called the office to relate that he is retiring from road racing (mostly due to financial considerations) and wanted to thank all the members for all the good times and experiences he has had. The CMRA will certainly miss Ruben's unique and exciting style. If anyone needs a good rider you might try luring him out of retirement. Ruben's number is (512) 923-5565.

This is just a reminder that only licensed competitors may use the track at Oak Hill. An Associate membership is not a license. If you rent the track for practice, you are responsible for any tuners or friends who are with you. Our insurance covers only properly licensed riders and we could lose it if unlicensed riders use the track. Allowing a non-licensed person on the track could cost you a fine and/or a suspension of your license.

We broke in a new starter at Oak Hill and a few of the experts took advantage of it. Be forewarned, that from the time the board changes from two to one, until the green flag is pulled, that your front tire must stay in contact with the paint line that marks your grid position. You are to stay at your position, in a DEAD STOP, with no wheels rolling until the signal to start is given. Some of you are staging behind your line and then attempting to creep as the flag waves. At the next race, any racer who's front tire is not in contact with his paint line at the one minute board will be docked five positions. There is no "one bike length" allowance, your front tire is either touching the paint or it isn't. Anyone who moves forward (even the slightest) before the flag will be docked five positions. If you move forward and then manage to move back before the flag, you are still guilty and will be docked five positions. Creeps, consider this your final warning. And another thing, some of you seem to think that there is some advantage to be gained by hurrying to the finish line when a race has been red flagged. Nothing could be further from the truth. All scoring is backed up to the previous complete green flag lap. A lap is not complete until the leader starts another lap under green. Also, some of you have been making "insurance" laps (taking the checkered flag twice) after the endurance races. We will deduct a lap the next time it happens.

If you want to receive your free subscription to Roadracing World, you must fill out a requestor

form and return it to CMRA. Requestor forms are available at Registration or call the CMRA office.

Attention all Suzuki Contingency racers. There is a new rule this year that each Superstock class must have at least five entries to pay money (this should be no problem). Katanas are no longer eligible.

WERA made a few revisions to their 1992 rulebook just before our last race. Here they are:

1) Brake master cylinders no longer need to be taped 2) "R" type clips no longer need to be wired shut but do need to be wired to the machine. 3) Yamaha RZ350's are allowed in Formula Two 4) Honda VF500's and Hawk 650 twins are allowed in D Production and D Superbike. 5) Honda CB400F's are allowed in Formula Clubman. Remember, steering dampers are mandatory on all

machines (except YSR's). This will be enforced at TWS.

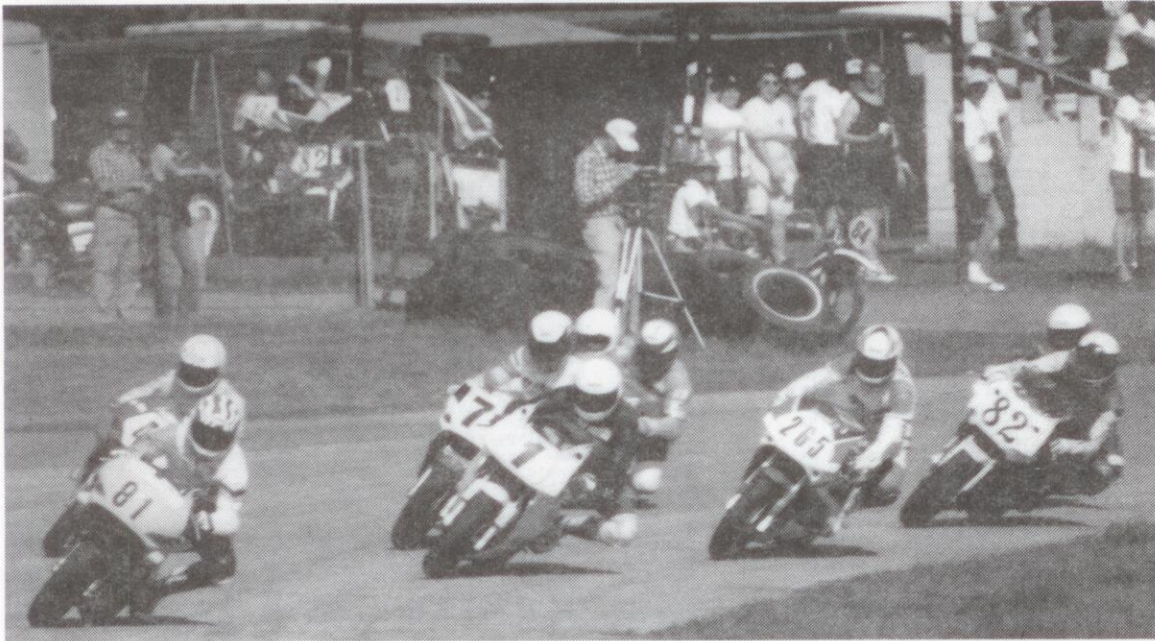
