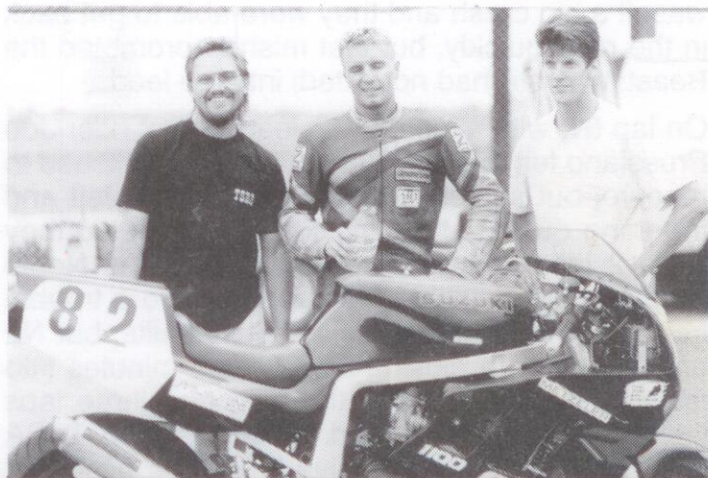
TSBA WINS WILD ONE AT TWS

Robert Marsh has certainly experienced his share of misfortune in the last two years of running Team TSBA in the CMRA Endurance series. Let's see—there was the throttle cable failure (while leading), the clutch basket explosion, the running out of gas (while leading), the transmission failure, the rod through the cases at San Angelo, the tire meltdowns, and last but not least of course, the crashes. Well, the team finally broke through all that and took their first overall victory at round five of the series at Texas World Speedway. Team riders Mark Black, Jim Frisbee, and Robert Marsh completed 181 laps in the four hour period and held off the vaunted N2 Racing Team by 15 seconds at the finish.

It was an excellent race, never dull, and chock full of pleasant surprises, not the least of which was the weather. At the six hour in June, it was so hot that the race resembled a Death March, with riders almost begging for relief as they signaled their pits to get another rider ready. As a result, this round was shortened to four hours but they needn't have bothered because, ta da... Would you believe a cool front in August? That's just what greeted the forty two teams as they made their way out to the Speedway.

After a nice appetizer in the form of a two hour YSR endurance, the big bikes gridded up for the 3 p.m. start. On the pole sat TSBA's Mark Black and next to him The Legend's Michael Carter. A little further back was the CBR900RR of the N2 Racing Team with Jim Sabin at the controls and alongside another interesting entry Southwest Motorsports, an RC-30 piloted by Frank Klementich. The Noble Knights and The Beasts (with two wins a piece) seemed ready to continue their overall points battle. The most competitive class was Medium-weight Production where 14 teams were entered. HSR Endurance leads Dynatech II in the points

and the two are locked into a blood feud. Dynatech II even took the unusual step of beefing up their other team (Dynatech) so as to try to put HSR further down. In Lightweight Superbike, Black Fire, Cyclepath, and the Null Set were joined by a bunch of YSR pilots called Cooley Racing.

At the wave of the green flag (the light is broken) Mark Black powered TSBA into the lead ahead of N2, Legends, Too Strong, Helen Wheels, and Iron Horse. On lap two, N2 took the lead and began to pull away from the field, but not for long. On lap six N2 was in the pits with a flat front tire. Sabin sat patiently while the pit crew quickly changed the front wheel. Eight minutes later they were back in the race with almost four laps to make up. Later examination revealed that the metal valve stem gaskets were leaking. That put TSBA back into the lead and they began to put distance on The Legends while Beast fought with the Noble Knights.

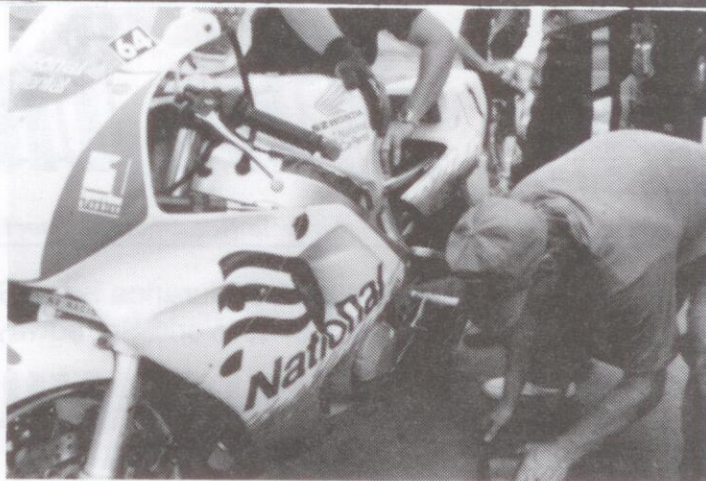

The Legends were the first to pit, coming in just forty minutes into the race while in second place. Most teams pitted on the hour including the leader TSBA who were shown with 45 laps, one more than the Noble Knights and the Beast. The Knights pitted on lap 47 but the Beasts stayed out. Their plan was to run to reserve and then come in. Fifteen minutes into the second hour saw the demise of the Legends as they crashed in turn ten. A few laps later they were joined by the race leader as TSBA's Jim Frisbee went down in turn four. It wasn't a big crash and they were able to get back in the race quickly, but that mishap promoted the Beast (who still had not pitted) into the lead.

On lap 61, with almost a lap lead, Beast rider Joe Prussiano felt the FZR600 sputter and switched to reserve, but somehow there was no gas left and the thing quit. By the time they got refueled they were 2 laps down to the new leader, the Noble Knights. The Knights continued to have a trouble free run and led the second hour results, but N2 and TSBA were closing fast. Fifteen minutes into the third hour N2 retook the lead and three laps later TSBA claimed second. When N2 pitted, TSBA took the lead but had to give it up for a pitstop of their own a few laps later. As the third hour wound down, N2 once again began to dominate and at the end of three hours, they had a lap on the field.

TSBA put Mark Black back on for the last hour and he did his best to make a run at N2. TSBA did manage to get back on the lead lap when N2 pitted but couldn't make much progress beyond that, as N2 picked it up the pace and held the interval. Then, with less than 30 minutes left, a small weakness revealed itself. The N2 machine, with a total loss ignition system built to run for the three

hour AMA races, went dead. A pit stop for a new battery turned a sixty second lead into a thirty second deficit. Michael Myers charged back out and tried to make it up, but Mark Black, informed by pit signals of the situation, responded and held the lead all the way to the checkered flag. N2 was second, Noble third, Beast fourth.

As always when there's great racing at the front, the class action tends to get covered up. In Mediumweight Production, HSR Endurance took another win over Vital II and Dynatech II. In Lightweight Super, it was CyclePath over BlackFire and the YSR newcomers, Cooley Racing.

As the series heads into the seven hour season finale, the class championships are all but decided. TSBA has HWS, the Knights have HWP, the Beasts have MWS, HSR has MWP, and it will take a miracle for the Null Set to catch BlackFire in LWS. The only thing that's left to decide is the Overall Champion. Beast leads Noble Knights by 56 hundredths of a point 466.42 to 465.86. Good luck and may the best team win.

DANNY WALKER DOUBLES TEXAS WORLD

There were a lot of fast riders at round seven of the CMRA sprint race series, but none faster than Danny Walker. He took victories in Formula One and Formula Two, turning lap times as low as 1:10.61 in the process. There weren't many other big news flashes, it was just your basic great club race. So without further ado, let's get to the action.

The Stock 50 class resembled a mini-IROC race for motorcycles as drafting played a large part. The lead pack traded positions constantly during the race but at the flag it was Chris Reed, Jay Deaton, Greg Mesa, Tommy Hickman, and Craig Waugh.

The C Superstock race was a good one. Joe Prussiano, riding a CBR600F2 borrowed from Dan Denero, led off the line and immediately had to fend off pass attempts from Robie McGonagill and a vicious pack of others. As they went past the starter for the first time, Joe continued to lead while Bridgeman passed McGonagill for second. Mark Black was already missing, having crashed in turn five. On the second lap, Bridgeman took the lead from Prussiano with a rare inside pass in turn one. Joe tried the same move on the next lap but wasn't quite able to pull it off. As Bridgeman upped the pace from 15's to 14's, Prussiano fell back and came under attack from Pete Martins. Pete easily drafted past Joe on lap six with Joe trying the same move a lap later, but it didn't work Pete's GSXR600 was just too strong. Joe's last lap chance was the infield, and when Pete almost lost the front end, Joe was able to set up a better drive onto the bowl and took second easily. McGonagill was a lonely fourth with Tatsuhiko Iino fifth and Jeff Covington sixth. In C Production Novice, Chris Rankin took the second

win of his career, topping a huge field while Toby Grace slipped past Greg Howard on the last lap for second.

Charles Ertle and Eric Falt had a good race long battle in Formula Clubman with Ertle getting the nod at the line. Stanley Huffman was third. Robert Higgenbotham backed up his win at Henderson with another victory in the Novice division over Jim Beedle's special Kawasaki and Michael Karnes aboard the "Death Dealer" XT500.

It's no secret that Greg Abbott's ZX-7R is one of the fastest 750's in the club and that Greg knows how to ride it. In B Superstock, he blew by early leader Jeb Bridgeman's F2 Honda on the straight and went on to win by an easy margin. Jeb maintained second while Mark Black (who has changed from number 186 to number 6) came in third on another one of the green meanies. Suzuki GSXR750 riders had to console themselves by collecting Suzuki bucks. James Schaefer, Robie McGonagill, Tracy LeBlanc, and Robert Marsh finished 4th, 5th, 7th and 10th place respectively.

Greg Howard, evidently not pleased with the third place he got in C Production, charged out and led every lap of B Production. Toby Grace was again second and Chris Rankin was third. Crash page star Todd Driggers was fourth with Don Campos fifth.

"You watch, I'm gonna be the man today", Tim Barnes claimed to this reporter as well as anyone else who would listen during the morning practice sessions. Well, after the Unlimited Twins race, you

had to hand it to him. He jumped out in front and didn't put a wheel wrong, taking the top spot in front of Robert Bates. Charles Ergle and Eric Falt resumed the battle they had in the Clubman race until Falt crashed on lap seven. Daniel Byerley won the Novice division for the third time in four tries, ahead of Jason Smith's booming Harley Davison and points leader Scott Dennis on his trusty Honda Hawk.

Team Toomer star Craig Gleason showed that there might be some life in the old GSXR after all as he beat Greg Abbott's fast Kawasaki handily in the B Superbike race. Mark Black was third. Greg Howard won the Novice segment ahead of Toby Grace and Charlie Brown.

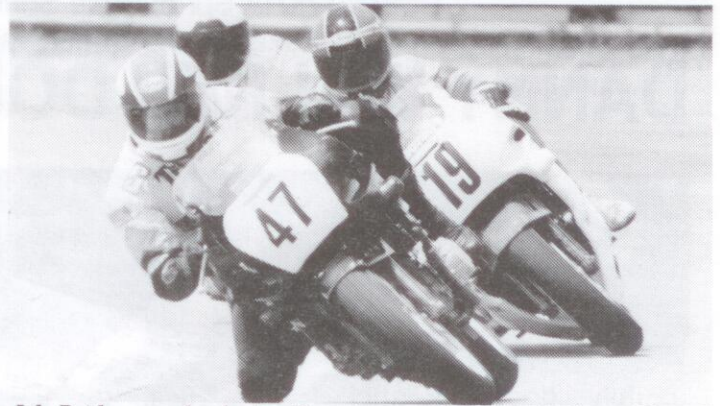
Robert Marsh won the D Production race again, so what else is new. Well, Sharon Earthman is beginning to return to form. She took second place ahead of William Comegys. Rob Tuluie won Vintage Four as expected ahead of Tony Lewis and David Hirsch. In Vintage Two it was Chris Cook, Ronnie Davila, and Richard Black.

A Superbike was a rerun of B Superbike minus Greg Abbott. Craig Gleason ran away with the win ahead of Mark Black and Robie McGonagill. In the Novice division, Charlie Brown finally got up to

speed and won ahead of Charlie Dill and Blake Bradley.

In Super 50, Stanley Huffman took his fifth win in a row, overcoming early leader Jay Deaton and Chris Reed, who won the Novice division. Greg Mesa and Darin Cooley rounded out the Novices.

The much anticipated Formula Two race was next, matching Colorado native Danny Walker against Jim Sabin and Doug Carmichael. Sabin put plenty of heat on Walker, but Danny was able to handle it and won. Carmichael dropped out at the halfway flag, promoting Damon Harvey to third. William Comegys was first in the Novice division ahead of Sharon Earthman and Ken Bailey.

THE LEGENDS TAKE TEXAS WORLD

The Legends outlasted and outran 24 teams to take their first win in the CMRA's YSR Endurance Series. Team riders Chris Reed and Michael Carter completed 66 laps to hold off N2 Racing and Attitude. In the Production class, M Cubed won for the second race in a row over Atomic Fireball, No BS, and Stealth.

Under cool and cloudy skies, S & I's Charles Ergle led off for the first eight laps before seizing and handing the lead over to Attitude's Barbie Spears. Remarkably, Barbie was riding the teams stock machine as their superbike had twisted the crank. Halfway into the first hour, Chris Reed found that

the Legends YSR went faster if he didn't hold it wide open. Using that technique he was able to reel in Attitude and by the halfway point The Legends were in the lead over Attitude and N2. In the Production class, M Cubed took the lead over Atomic Fireball just before the hour ended with the Moron Brothers in third.

In the final hour, the Legends continued to dominate but Attitude was robbed of second place three laps from the end by N2's Shake Phillips. M Cubed held onto the Production win from Atomic Fireball but third place went down to the wire with No BS just squeezing third from Stealth.

Next came Marc Vandament, crashing hard in turn nine and suffering a serious concussion. To top it all off, another rider crashed on the cool off lap. Jeb Bridgeman dodged all the debris to win the race ahead of Mark Black and Tatsuhiko Iino. Novicewise, it was Toby Grace, Greg Howard, and Chris Rankin. After the race there was a short delay while corner workers swept up all the broken plastic and waited for one of the ambulances to return.

Larry Locklear, still sore from falling off a scaffold at work, ran away with the A Superstock race ahead of Mark Black and James Schaefer. Greg Howard took win number three in the A Production race ahead of Toby Grace and Charlie Brown.

Kelly Moody has taken control of the D Superbike class and today was no different as he won easily over Robert Marsh and Rob Bradlaw. William Comegys took the Novice win over Sharon Earthman and Ken Bailey.

Ronnie Lunsford has the Vintage Five class pretty well under control. He won with Jack Bates second and Tracy LeBlanc third. Peter Pohlman won Vintage Three over R N Root and David Hirsch while John Hodgkiss took Formula Three ahead of Raul Davila and Randy French.

In the last race of the day (Formula One), Danny Walker again held off the challenges of Jim Sabin and Doug Carmichael but he really had to run to do it, turning a best time at 1:10.61.
